Reading:

In reading we read some different folktales. We talked about how folktales are stories that have been told for many, many years, often begin with the words "Once upon a time", and often have animal characters that speak and act like humans. There are so many different folktales!! Check some out from the library and read them with your child!

In writing we worked on informational and opinion paragraphs. We focused on making sure all sentences are complex, first grade sentences. When we say complex, we mean that the sentence needs to use conjunctions (so, because, and, for, but) or it needs to use commas in a series. This helps us write a quality paragraph. We also learned about verbs!

This week we worked more with place value, specifically tens and ones. Students need to know the value of each digit in a 2-digit number, and be able to draw it in model form.

We have completed NWEA for the winter! Thank you so much for helping your child log in.

We head back to in-person instruction this Tuesday, January 19th. Remember, because there is no school on Monday, students will attend in-person learning Tuesday-Friday next week.
