Science/Social Studies:

Christopher Columbus Day was celebrated on Monday. All week we learned about Christopher Columbus through reading information text.

We also read some books about bones! Students had to write a paragraph about what they learned about bones. They were fascinated to discover they are all skeletons!

Reading/Writing:

We read <u>Jasper's Beanstalk</u> and focused on story structure. We completed a story structure map throughout the week discussing: title, author, setting, characters, beginning, middle, end, and problem/solution.

In writing, we focused more on what makes up a complete sentence. Remind your child that for narrative writing, we always need a: who, doing what, where! Ask your child the hand signals that go with the saying! Students also began some Halloween writing!

Math:

This week we really focused on number bonds. Number bonds are a Common Core model used to show addition and subtraction. Students had to compose the number 10 and then write addition and subtraction sentences to go with their number bond. We also learned about the commutative property, which will set us up for fact families.
