Science/Social Studies:

This week we focused on turkeys and reading informational text about them. Students created a little informational booklet. We also made our outfits for our Friendship Soup Feast!

Reading/Writing:

We read <u>The Secret Code</u> and focused on evaluating the story and comparing and contrasting. Be sure to practice the words "compare" and "contrast" with your child. They used a Venn Diagram to compare and contrast events in the story, along with the vowel e and "super e".
