Math:


This week we wrapped up Unit 5. A study guide was sent home on Tuesday! Our Unit 5 math test is on Monday. We worked a lot this unit with tens, making tens, and adding and subtracting tens. Dreambox has guite a few games that relate to this skill. Please make sure your child is completing Dreambox as required as the games and the way they are structured tremendously help your child with developing a deep understanding of math concepts.

| Reading: |
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In reading we completed Unit 4 Week 3. We read non-fiction texts about animals. We learned about how animals survive in nature. We worked a lot on asking and answering questions, along with main idea and key details. Practice identifying the main idea and key details at home. It is tricky for first graders! They tend to say the main idea would be just animals, opposed to how animals survive in nature. The key details would be examples from the book showing how animals survive in nature. Practice this with non-fiction texts at home.

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In writing we wrote some informational paragraphs about Dr. Seuss characters. When your child's paper comes home with editing marks on it, please make sure you have your child correct the paper so he/she is learning from the mistakes.





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
